

## Junior CYO Event rules and Dress Code

1. Admission is limited to 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade members only. **Members** will be required to sign in at events, and provide an emergency contact number (if one is not already available).
2. Guests are welcome at each dance (**with a limit of one (1) guest per member**). Guests must be in the **6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Guests must be signed in by the parent of the member** accompanying the guest, and an emergency contact number provided.
3. Event times are listed. We will not be responsible for children who are dropped off earlier or picked up later than the printed times.
4. No backpacks or containers of any kind will be allowed inside the school/old church. Please leave these at home.
5. No cell phone use is permitted at events. Please see a chaperone if you need to use your phone.
6. Once inside, no one is allowed to leave an event unless being picked up by a parent. If a parent is picking you up early, you must bring a note signed by your parent indicating who is picking you up and at what time. Only children with a note will be permitted to leave. **Any child who leaves an event without permission will be banned from all future Jr. CYO activities for the remainder of the school year.**
7. No one will be admitted to an event beyond one hour of its start time.
8. Dress code: Proper attire is expected. No tube tops, tank tops, belly shirts, inappropriate words on T-shirts, pants worn too low (undergarments showing) or other distasteful outfits are allowed at any Jr. CYO activity. If you are inappropriately dressed, you will not be admitted to the event.
9. At dances, respectful distance should be maintained during slow dances. No moshing or foul language is permitted.
10. Please be advised that any rude or inappropriate behavior will be dealt with as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> time – a verbal warning
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> time – 10-15 minute cool-down period
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> time – phone call to parent and dismissal from event
