Dear Parents/Guardians,

God's blessings to you!

Registration for P.R.E.P. (Parish Religious Education Program) for the 2010-2011 school year begins today and continues through March 28/29. All registrations are due in the office by March 28/29, 2010. Any registrations received after this date will be put on a waiting list for the session desired. Please do not assume that your child will be automatically assigned to the session preference from previous years.

Attached please find a new registration form – one form per family. There is also one form included if you have a 3- or 4-year old for the Toddler Program. The Toddler Program runs simultaneously with Mass time. You can contact the PREP office if you have any questions about the Toddler Program.

At registration be sure to bring the **original** sacrament certificate(s) for your child(ren) and a copy of each at the time of registration and a \$25 registration fee/family. Registration will not be accepted without these. We will be in the school cafeteria accepting the registrations before and after the sessions on March 21/22 and March 28/29. Please do not send the registrations in the mail because of the requirement to see original sacrament certificates. Also, I request that you be forthright about your child's academic challenges. It is unfair to both your child and the teacher if we are not aware of any assistance your child may need to be successful. Be assured, as in any academic setting, that information shared is held in strictest confidence.

Tuition for **Toddler Bible School** for 2010-2011 is **\$60.00**.

You will receive a tuition bill from the rectory on July 1, 2010. If the registration form has not been received in the PREP office by June 30, a **\$25 late fee/child** will be assessed and included on the tuition bill.

Our Program encompasses children from Kindergarten through Junior High School. Both Kindergarten and Junior High will be offered on Sundays and Mondays next year. Please understand, though, that there will not be a class offered if less than 10 students request a certain session.

I strongly encourage you, the parents, to continue your child's religious education beyond the Confirmation year. With the ever-changing morals in today's society and the issues that bombard our young people on a daily basis, I do not believe that our children can ever hear or learn enough about our Catholic response.

In mid-August, class assignments will be mailed to each family that returned their completed registration forms and paid their tuition. A class will not be assigned if both registration and tuition have not been received by August 15. **Classes will begin on September 12/13, 2010.**
