IMPORTANT P.R.E.P INFORMATION FOR 2021-2022

- **ORIGINAL BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATES** for all new students **MUST** be presented to the P.R.E.P. office in the month of September.
- In the event of financial hardship, please place your request for P.R.E.P. tuition assistance in writing to the attention of the Father William Monahan. On-line registration will not be completed without payment.
- The first day of class is September 12-13, 2021. Class assignments will be posted at this time prior to class in the cafeteria. All students are to have the student **WAIVER** completed. This is on the PREP webpage on the parish website.
- **CONFIRMATION:** Students are required to enroll and attend P.R.E.P. classes from Grade Level 1 to Grade Level 7 to receive their Confirmation in Grade Level 7. Classroom attendance, knowledge of the curriculum and parental involvement in Grade Levels 1-7 are necessary components. Cooperation, participation, meeting calendar deadlines and attendance at the scheduled parent meetings are requirements. Sacrament calendars, curriculum study guides, phone and email reminders and timelines with specific deadlines are issued to assist you. The student must successfully fulfill all the requirements by the specified deadlines. Confirmation in Grade Level 7 will take place after all the requirements are fulfilled.
- **FIRST RECONCILIATION:** Students are required to successfully complete Grade Levels 1 - 2 to receive First Reconciliation in Grade Level 2. Classroom attendance, knowledge of the curriculum and parental involvement with Grade Levels 1 -2 are necessary components. Parental cooperation, participation and attendance at the scheduled parent meetings are requirements. First Reconciliation in Grade Level 2 will take place after all the requirements are fulfilled. Sacrament calendars, curriculum study guides, phone and email reminders and requirement deadlines are issued to assist you.
- **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION:** Students are required to successfully complete Grade Levels 1- 2- 3 to receive First Eucharist in Grade Level 3. Classroom attendance, knowledge of the curriculum and parental involvement with Grade Levels 1 -2-3 are necessary components. Parental cooperation, participation and attendance at the scheduled parent meetings are requirements. First Eucharist in Grade Level 3 will take place after all the requirements are fulfilled. Sacrament calendars, curriculum study guides, phone and email reminders and requirement deadlines are issued to assist you.
- Students who are in other grade levels and have not received the sacraments will have a specific catechetical plan that will go into effect after meeting with the DRE. This curriculum plan will provide the required tenets of the Catholic Faith, the specific requirements for the reception of the Sacrament and a curriculum timeline for at home instruction. With parental involvement, all essential components could be completed prior to the reception of the Sacrament.
