

To the Parish Family of Saint John's,

This past weekend, Archbishop Perez published a Pastoral Letter to the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. In this letter, our Archbishop expresses his hopes and desires for the future of our Archdiocese. One of the topics that he has stressed since his arrival is his desire for each of us to understand our role as "Missionary Disciples" in our world. As a parish family, we continue to discern what this means for our lives of faith and how we integrate this understanding into our everyday living.

The future of the faith in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia continues to be both filled with hope and challenge! At this point in our local church history, it is a time when we ALL need to evaluate, plan and reengage in the important work of evangelization. This may entail a "pastoral change of heart" as described by the Archbishop. To experience this change, we must re-examine and assess "the way we have always done things" and to "cast out into the deep" with faith, hope and courage. Now is the time for us to actively engage and participate in our faith, and to invite others to do the same. I strongly encourage you to read this letter with an open heart and mind, and to be ready to respond accordingly.

The Archdiocese will be hosting multiple "Archdiocesan Consultation Sessions" across the region, with numerous meetings to be held within Bucks County. There are sessions in other locations as well during which the people of the Archdiocese are invited to gather, to listen, and to respond so that this process can proceed with great confidence in our sense of mission and courage to engage the world around us!

This pastoral vision of the Archbishop has been put together after the careful study of various plans occurring in a number of other dioceses across the country. Throughout this process, the clergy and other individuals in Archdiocesan leadership have gathered to listen, provide feedback and insights, and respond to our Archbishop, offering him both our words of encouragement and our continued commitment to drawing all people to Christ and living His call to evangelize to all corners of the world!

I would also ask that you join me in prayer during this journey of faith, with a renewed trust in where the Lord is leading us. Saint John's continues to remain a place of welcome and opportunity for people to nurture and deepen their faith through the sacramental, pastoral, apostolic and social events and ministries we offer.

# ADULT CATHOLIC INITIATION (OCIA) A Journey of Faith

This weekend the Christmas season ends, and so we now hear Luke's Gospel account of the Baptism of an older Jesus who is praying as the Holy Spirit descends on him and as he experiences affirmation from heaven of him and of the work he is about to begin.

When we receive Baptism as infants, we complete our initiation sacraments later, as we grow in faith and understanding. The Eucharist helps nourish and strengthen us for that journey of faith; and Confirmation bestows on us many spiritual gifts as the Holy Spirit descends upon us and inspires us to answer God's call.

If you have been baptized but are not yet confirmed, our OCIA team can help you prepare for and celebrate this wonderful Sacrament. We welcome questions from adults or older teens and can explain the steps our current group of candidates will be engaged in between now and Easter.
