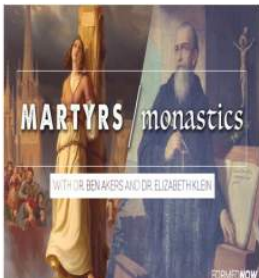
### The Presentation
