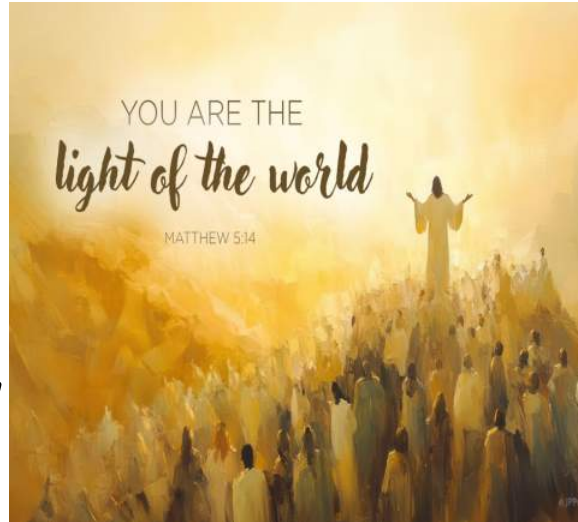

Join us in saying this daily prayer that has eternal benefits.

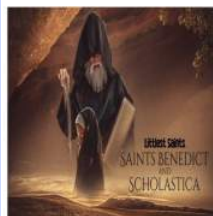

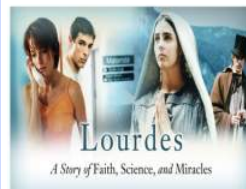
