



This Week's Facts of Our Faith

Q. How may the years of Christ's life be divided?

A. The years of Christ's life may be divided into three parts: 1) His childhood, extending from His birth to His twelfth year, when He went with His parents to worship in the Temple of Jerusalem; 2) His hidden life, extends from His twelfth to His thirtieth year, during which time He dwelt with His parents at Nazareth; 3) His public life, extending from His thirtieth year-to His death; during which time He taught His doctrines and established His Church.

Q. Why is Christ's life thus divided?

A. Christ's life is thus divided to show that all classes find in Him their model. In childhood He gave an example to the young; in His hidden life an example to those who consecrate themselves to the service of God in a religious state; and in His public life an example to all Christians without exception.


