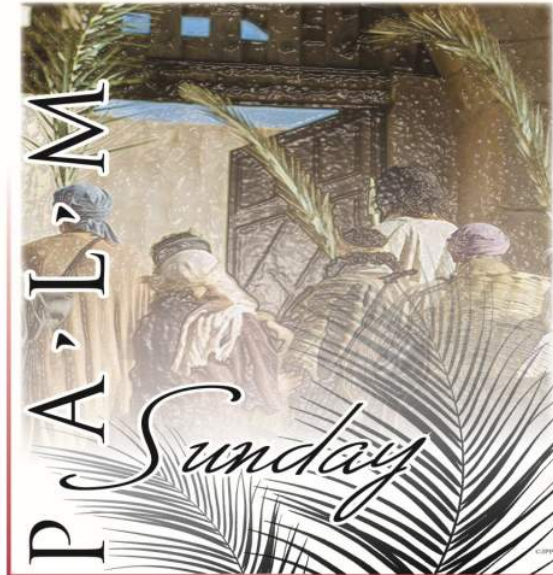

OCIA: Catholic Initiation of Adults

ENTERING HOLY WEEK

This weekend our adult candidates for Full Initiation gather to observe Palm Sunday. Along with our parish they will hear the emotional account of our Lord's Passion. They will take home their palms and prepare for the three most holy days of our church year: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. These are the final days in their preparation to become fully initiated members of the Catholic Church.

- + **On Holy Thursday evening**, they will join us at the unique and beautiful Mass of the Lord's Supper. Following the example set by Jesus, our pastor will wash the feet of several of our candidates, as a sign that we must all humbly serve God by serving one another.
- + **On Good Friday**, our candidates will participate in the afternoon liturgy with Adoration of the Cross.
- + **Holy Saturday** is a quiet time of waiting for the Easter Vigil. Our parish and candidates will gather joyfully at dusk for that first Mass of the Easter season as together we celebrate Christ's Resurrection with the lighting and blessing of new fire.

During this Easter Vigil Mass, our eight adult candidates, through Confirmation, and some through First Eucharist, will complete their Sacraments of Initiation.

We welcome and pray for them all. They are a great blessing to our faith community.

Facts of Our Faith

Q. What did Jesus Christ suffer?

A. Jesus Christ suffered a bloody sweat, a cruel scourging, was crowned with thorns, and was crucified.

Q. On what day did Christ Die?

A. Christ died on Good Friday.

Q. Why do you call that day “good” on which Christ suffered so sorrowful a death?

A. We call that day good on which Christ died, because by His death He showed His great love for man, and purchased for him every blessing.

Q. Where did Christ die?

A. Christ died on Mount Calvary.

Q. How did Christ die?

A. Christ was nailed to a cross and died on it, between two thieves.

Q. Why did Christ suffer and die?

A. Christ suffered and died for our sins.

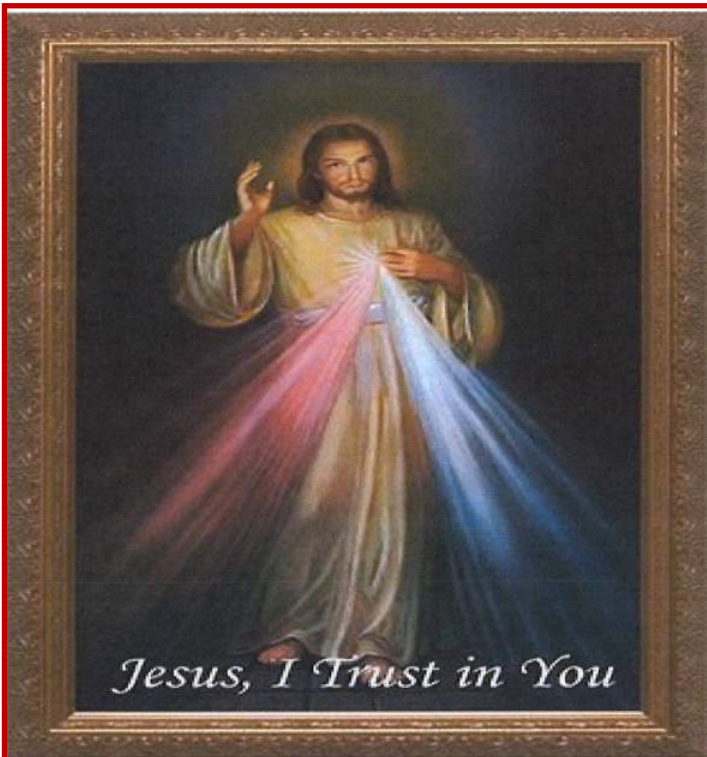

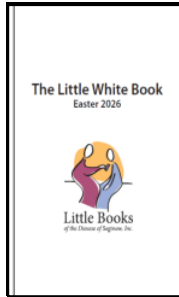
