OCIA: Adult Catholic Initiation
**HANDING ON OF THE CREED
AND THE LORD'S PRAYER**

How and why do we do this?

During Lent, as our Adult Initiation candidates prepare for the Easter Vigil, the Church formally hands on to them words that we treasure: the Creed and the Lord's Prayer. During a designated Mass, the priest and the community of faithful recite, and the candidates receive, the precious Creed that summarizes our faith. The prayer that Jesus taught us (which St. Augustine called the most perfect prayer) is then handed on to them during a smaller gathering of the community for weekday Mass or faith sharing service.

As our candidates prepare to complete their Sacraments, they are continuing to attend Sunday Mass together at 9:30 am. After each liturgy, they gather with members of the OCIA Team to reflect on the day's Gospel and learn more about our Catholic faith and traditions. **On this Fourth Sunday of Lent**, during their group session, they will focus on the Lord's Prayer, which St. Augustine called "the most perfect prayer." It will be ritually handed on to them to treasure and teach to new generations. **Then, during the week ahead**, they will participate in a Lenten Retreat.

Next Sunday, April 6th, our Adult Initiation Team and candidates will be sponsoring the parish Bakery Basket. Do stop by for a beverage and pastry after 9:30 or 11:30 Mass and say hello. We will be happy to answer questions about OCIA, adult Sacraments, or becoming a Catholic.
