Join Brother Francis in this entertaining and guidance-filled presentation that will inspire children to deepen their faith by praying the Rosary.

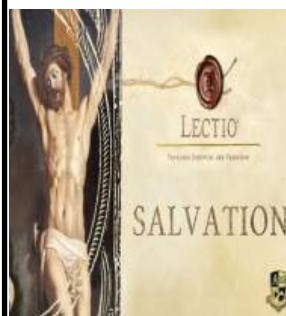
### Why Catholics believe in "life everlasting"
