## This Week's Facts of our Faith

- Q. What is necessary for the worthy reception of Holy Communion?
  - A. For the worthy reception of Holy Communion three things are necessary: first, to be in a state of grace; second, to recognize and consider Whom we are about to receive; third, to observe the Eucharistic fast. (CCC 1385-87)
- Q. What does it mean to be in a state of grace?
  - A. Being in a state of grace means to be free of all serious sin. (CCC 1861)
- Q. How should we receive Holy Communion?
  - A. We should receive Holy Communion reverently and prayerfully. We must be reverent in our behavior and even in our clothing, remembering that we are receiving Jesus Christ as our guest. (CCC 1386-87)
- Q. What does the Eucharistic fast require?
  - A. The Eucharistic fast requires one who is to receive Holy Communion to abstain from food or drink (except water or medicine) for one hour before Holy Communion. (CCC13987, CIC, Canon 919)


