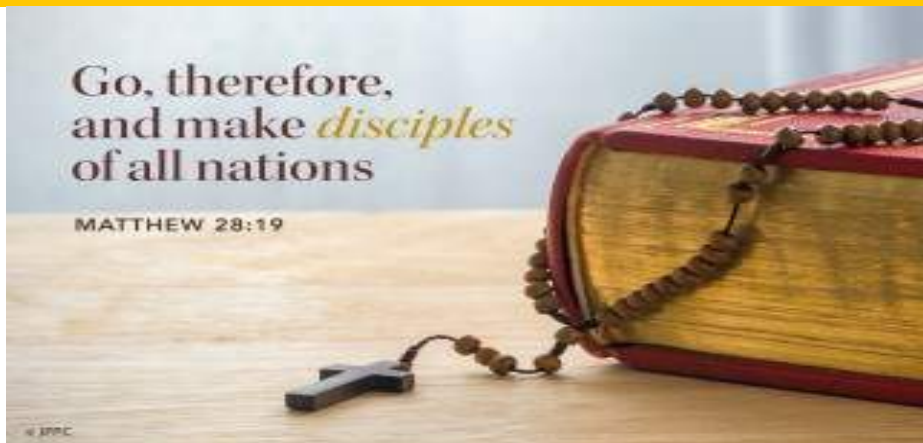

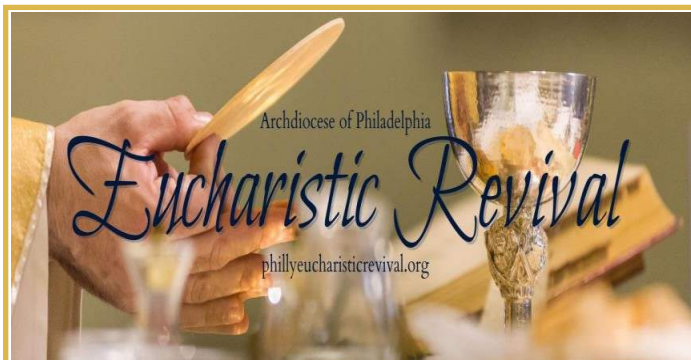
To the Parish Family of Saint John's,

To qualify for the Scholarship, students must be enrolled in a Catholic high school or academy in the 2024/2025 school year.

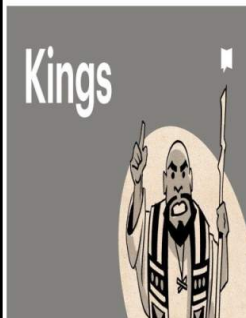

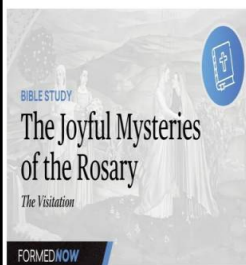

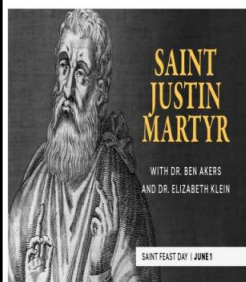
1 and 2 Kings/Old Testament: Book Overviews/The Bible Project

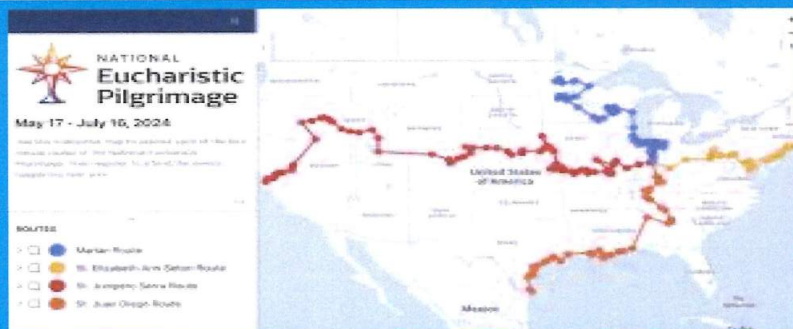

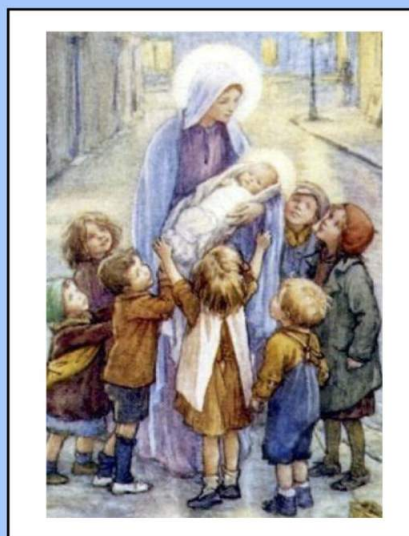
