


The Saint John the Evangelist Knights of Columbus are proud to add the Jesse Tree to our list of charitable programs that serve our parish's vibrant community.


Intramural Basketball season are now open for Grades PreK-4 to 3rd Grade. Practices start December 14th. Registration fee is \$55.00.
